

2012 FCBC Level III League/Tryout Information

Player Tryout Profile Card: Each Player trying out for the Level III League is asked to complete this card prior to trying out. This card is used as a tool for coaches to learn more about the player and the commitments that they may have in relationship to this League.

- Practicing may begin around mid-March.
- Teams may incur additional expense for booking of practice fields through City or School District, along with any outside tournaments in which teams choose to participate.
- Three training sessions per team will begin the week of April 16th with at least two practices a week running until May 15th.
- An inter-league Umpire Training Scrimmage will be held May 19th and 20th.
- League Season will begin on May 21st – July 22nd. End of Season Tournament will be held July 20th thru 22nd. **Families need to be prepared to have their players attend these events.**

Level III Baseball is designed for players who will be **turning 9 by April 30th and not older than 12 by April 30th**. This league is not intended for players who are younger than 9 years of age.

Level III Draft will be conducted on February 27th. All players selected will be contacted by a coach by March 1st.

- All players selected to a Level III Team will be posted to the FCBC website by March 1st.
- Players **not drafted** will remain on their school team in the Recreational League to which they have already been assigned.
- Maximum number of FROZEN Players that may be assigned to a Level III Team is five. Maximum number of players per team is twelve.
- Total maximum number of teams in Level III is 12. This number is not based on meeting the maximum number, but rather on the QUALIFIED COACHING STAFFS that are selected by December 5th deadline. This may allow for one or of the other age groups to have more or fewer coaches. FCBC **will not add** any additional teams to the league other than teams and coaches currently selected. If limited numbers of draft-able players are fewer than projected teams then at them existing may be combined.
- **"Fort Collins Baseball Club reserves the right to adjust and reconfigure the leagues according to the best interest of the Club, the Coaching Staffs and the Players, according to the age-ratio of players trying out."**

Upon selection to a Level III Team, players will be removed from the Recreational League. FCBC cannot guarantee placement back to a recreational team if players choose to back out after tryouts and draft.

- Dropping OFF the team: If you back out after tryouts and draft, FCBC cannot guarantee placement back onto the same recreational school team. No refunds are provided. Neither will players who are 'called up' to a Travel team be refunded the Rec portion of their fees. In addition, any additional fees accrued must be paid for – either by the parent or by the Travel team who is calling up the player.

All COACHES in the Level III Program agree to have Character Development Program within their teams.

Uniforms: All Level 3 teams will be given a team uniform box to use for sizing of their players' uniforms

Team Fees: \$4200.00 per team (12 players on team). Team fees include 4 weeks of training sessions, umpire training scrimmage games, 12-14 league games, end of season playoff and uniform. Players will **pay the balance of team fees, less recreational fees**. These are paid directly to their Coach. Teams will receive an invoice for balance **due on April 1st**. To off-set additional team fees above the recreational league fee, some teams may choose to fundraise as a team, or seek team sponsorships. **League Fees**: This is the difference between your recreational fee and the Level III. Balance is **due April 1st**.
